



## **Improvement of Forestry Education in Kenya, HEI-ICI project**

International Partnership for Forestry Education (IPFE) is participating to a forestry education development project "Improvement of Forestry Education in Kenya". The project is coordinated by University of Eastern Finland and IPFE and ANAFE are participating to the project in information dissemination and expert position. In addition the chair of IPFE professor Hosny El Lakany is a member of the Project Board.

The overall objective of the project is to enhance the management and conservation of forests and other tree resources in Kenya for sustainable environment and socio-economic development as stated in the Kenya Forestry Policy through improved forestry education in the country.

Project Purpose is capacity building of forestry education at Moi University utilizing the expertise in forestry and ICT of the University of Eastern Finland through training of teachers on new learning methodologies including improving educational materials and practices, and providing support and training on the use of ICT in education.

ANAFE and IPFE will act as channels for information dissemination concerning the development of forestry education both in Africa and globally. This could include e.g. new ideas and tools for improvement of professional education and training, partnering and networking.
